WHEREAS, TRIPURA UNIVERSITY with its cryptic motto 'pursuit of excellence' has dedicated itself to this noble task ever since it had been launched on October 02.1987. It epitomizes the aspiration of the state's people of academic excellence at the highest level and quest for knowledge. Tripura University provides Masters Degree programme in 44 Departments. Twenty One general and Seventeen technical colleges, five professional degree colleges, four applied Arts degree Colleges and two Agriculture and allied colleges within the state are affiliated with Tripura University which is now the veritable nerve center of the state's higher education, enjoying the highest possible autonomy in all matters.

The Department of Botany came into existence on 12th of June, 2007 through the trifurcation of the Department of Life Science, established in 1976, with the objective of providing post graduate qualification to the students of the state of Tripura. Add on course on "Biology and Farming of Mushroom" will jointly run by Mycology and Plant Pathology Laboratory (Under guidance of Prof. Ajay Krishna Saha) Department of Botany of Tripura University and Department of Botany Holy Cross College.

WHEREAS, HCC(UG) the Department of Botany came into existence in July 2018 through the trifurcation of the Department of Biological Sciences with the objective of providing proper knowledge about the Subject Botany to the students of the state of Tripura. Already, a research project funded by DBT New Delhi has been completed successfully by the Department. The major thrust areas of study of the Department are Agronomy, Cytology, Plant breeding, Plant Physiology, Taxonomy, Economic Botany Forestry, Gymnosperm, phycology, Mycology, Palynology and Molecular biology. The Department is headed by Dr. Dipanwita Chaudhuri Sil.

WHEREAS, TRIPURA UNIVERSITY and HCC (UG) recognize the particular role of each party in advancing and supporting activities related to the Add on the course on "Biology and Farming of Mushroom" which will be jointly run by the Mycology and Plant Pathology Laboratory, Department of Botany of Tripura University and Department of Botany of Holy Cross College, Lembucherra, with an objective to increase sustainable employment and livelihood opportunities, economic development, and environmental benefits, through the course outcome of skill development for farming of Mushroom along with the use of plant waste to produce protein rich food items having huge nutraceutical properties.

NOW, THEREFORE THIS MOU WITNESSESTH AS UNDER:-

Article I

Collaboration

- 1. The One semester programme (AC) shall be jointly organized by Tripura University and HCC (UG) form Academic Session 2022-2023 onwards.
- 2. One semester programme (AC) has been prepared by an expert committee constituted for the purpose prepared by Tripura University& HCC (UG).
- 3. The Course (AC) shall be conducted in 6 months and shall include the theory and practical lectures. Both the institutes (TU& HCC UG) will be involved to conduct the Add-on Course.
- 4. Both the institutes shall work together for making the course industry-oriented and job oriented and shall be leading towards the recognition of model course for the Mushroom production sector.
- 5. Whereas both the institutes shall bring expertise to acquire special knowledge by involving other reputed agencies.
- 6. The financial structure and revenue mechanism shall be prepared jointly by both the institutes depending upon the needs and requirements.

Article II

Amendment to this MoU

1. Amendment to this MoU shall be made by mutual consent of the writing. No variation in the terms of scope of this MoU shall be valid or binding unless previously expressly agreed upon in writing between the Parties in the form of a letter entitled "Amendment to MoU".

Article III Dispute Settlement Mechanism

- 1. Both the parties hereby agree that before approaching any court of law, they would enter into discussions regarding any point of conflict through direct negotiations.
- 2. Both the parties agree that the disputes not settled amicably shall be submitted exclusively to an Arbitrator appointed on manual agreement. The resulting award by the Arbitrator shall be final and binding on both the parties.

Article IV Entry into Force and Term

- MoU comes into effect on the date of signing by both the parties. The validity of this
 MoU shall be for five years with renewal for a similar period based on review
 necessary modifications and mutual consensus.
- 2. Each party shall have the right to withdraw from the Agreement on six months notice in writing. Such a termination will, however, not affect activities already approved jointly or under the progress under the terms of this Memorandum.
- 3. All notices, requests, reports, documents and other information and communication relating to this MoU shall be writing in the English language.





- 10. Candidates enrolled for the course shall be eligible to receive a certificate only if they have shown consistent performance and successfully completed the course by passing the evaluation and examination conducted by SIFS INDIA. The certificates to the successful candidates will be issued jointly by SIFS INDIA and Department of Zoology, Holy Cross College.
- 11. Any misconduct or indiscipline behaviour by the student will result in the cancellation of the admission from the program.
- 12. Logo of both the parties can be used by both mentioned parties only related to the purpose of these programs. If to be used at any other purpose, written consent shall be taken from the opposite party.
- 13. The Department of Zoology, Holy Cross College shall not have any copyright on the study material of the program prepared and distributed by SIFS INDIA.
- 14. Both the institution agrees to maintain the confidentiality of this agreement and all confidential information (written or oral) shared with each other or which comes to their knowledge under or as a result of this agreement and shall not divulge such information to any third party under any circumstances without prior written consent to the opposite party. Both the parties acknowledge and accept that they shall not require any rights, title or interest in either party's trademarks, patents, copyrights, ideas, methods and designs.
- 15. The Department of Zoology, Holy Cross College shall be liable to sign the certificate of programs by the end of completion of the mentioned advance certificate programs.
- 16. The Department of Zoology, Holy Cross College can gather enrollments apart from their institution making sure that the minimum eligibility requirements are met for the program.
 Department of Zoology, The Holy Cross College can pass on the proposal to their affiliating university for collaborating with other colleges.
- 17. Desired Credits will be given to the students as per guidelines followed by the Department of Zoology, The Holy Cross College.
- 18. All disputes to this agreement shall resolved under jurisdiction of Delhi and Agartala Only.

- Admission to the Programs shall solely be done by Department of Zoology, Holy Cross
 College. A minimum of 15 students per program is required to be fulfilled for the program to
 run effectively by SIFS INDIA.
- The list of students shall be provided by Department of Zoology, Holy Cross College to SIFS
 INDIA to conduct the program. All strategies of marketing and increasing the reach shall be beared primarily by Holy Cross College.
- 4. Once admission closes before commencement of the program, **Department of Zoology**, **Holy Cross College** shall provide the list of students within 30 working days to **SIFS INDIA**.
- 5. SIFS INDIA shall provide its own copyrighted online sessions, practice hands-on sessions, study material and 24*7 access to study portal. The Department of Zoology, Holy Cross College shall not be held liable if SIFS INDIA fails to fulfil above said deliverables to the students.
- 6. The collection of fee shall be solely done by **Department of Zoology**, **Holy Cross College** and the collected fee shall be shared between both parties. The share is divided as 75% to be delivered to **SIFS INDIA** and 25% to **Department of Zoology**, **Holy Cross College**.
- 7. From its 75% share of SIFS INDIA, Department of Zoology, Holy Cross College shall give 75% of the share before commencement (after admissions) of the Program and rest 25% after the completion of the said Program.
- 8. All sessions will be delivered to students via online platform, arranged solely by SIFS INDIA.
- The Department of Zoology, Holy Cross College shall make a mandatory exam for the delivered program in its optional subjects or otherwise at their convenience which shall be held through Online Mode by SIFS INDIA.


