This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is made on 30th. Day of September 2024

Institute of Advanced Studies in Education, Kunjaban, a Post Graduate Teacher Education Institute under the Department of Education (Higher), Government of Tripura, is situated in green and serene surroundings opposite to Heritage Park, Kunjaban, Agartala West Tripura district, PIN: 799006 (herein after called 'IASE, Kunjaban'), represented by Dr Ratna Roy, Principal which expression shall unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to mean and include its successor, legal representatives and permitted assigns.

AND

Holy Cross College, Agartala, a multidisciplinary Institute, set up by the Congregation of Holy Cross to offer quality Teacher Education programmes in the state. The college is situated at Jubatara, Lembucherra Agartala, West Tripura, PIN: 799210, (herein after called HCC, Tripura'), represented by Dr. Dr. Fr. Benny K. John, CSC, Principal which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to mean and include its successors and assigns.

1.BACKGROUND

IASE, Kunjaban, established in July, 1964, is the premiere teacher education institution in the State. The institute is affiliated to Tripura University, recognised by UGC under section 2 (f)& 12(B) of the UGC Act 1956 and the courses it offers are recognised by NCTE. The intake capacity of the college is 150 (3 Units) for B..Ed. Programme and 50 (1 Unit) for M.Ed. Programme. Besides offering quality pre-service teacher education programme, the institution makes a significant contribution in need based in-service teacher education, curriculum planning, designing teaching modules. With its experienced and talented teacher educators, massive infrastructure, state of the art facilities, the institute is committed to enhance quality education in the state by continually supporting and guiding the teachers, schools and other TEIs under the dynamic leadership of our Principal and the entire team of IASE.

Holy Cross College is a private English medium Catholic institution of higher learning founded, animated and enlivened by the Congregation of Holy Cross, a community of scholarship and faith, anchored by a belief in the inherent dignity of each person. It is a coeducational institution of higher learning with a clear focus on 'holistic education', educating the hearts and minds of the young. This institution provides opportunities of scholarship for academically qualified college graduates and prospective teachers, predominantly from the state

of Tripura and from any other parts of India. HCC will provide its students with an education marked by academic excellence, respect for the inherent dignity of every person, and a commitment to serving the common good of humanity

2. PURPOSE & SCOPE

The goal of cooperation will be accomplished in various ways which may include:

- Joint Research Activity
- Faculty & Student Exchange Programme
- Collaborative Faculty Development, Staff Development Programmes
- Joint Seminar, Conference, Workshop
- Collaborative Consultancy & Projects
- Technical Assistance and/or training, Practice Teaching
- Other cooperative efforts as may be specified later.

3. OUTLINE OF COLLABORATION

Under the aegis of this agreement, the parties shall jointly explore the possibilities of working mainly in Tripura. The broad areas of cooperation would include the following:-

- a. Designing viable and feasible roadmap for joint collaboration;
- b. Planning and organizing seminar, conference, workshop, training and capacity building programmes in the domains of teacher education, higher education, school education, new enterprise creation and other common areas of specialization of both the institutions.
- c. Based on speciality in the field, cooperation among the faculties of both institutions for carrying out research in various programmes.
- d. Undertake joint activities in rural areas under national flagship programmes like Ek Bharat Shrestha Bharat, Swachh Bharat Abhiyan, Unnat Bharat Abhiyan etc and other central & State Government projects.
- e. Extending collaboration for implementation of Sustainable Development Goals and Education Sustainable Development (ESD) Practices.
- f. Conducting Faculty Development Programmes for the staff of both the institutes.

The separate Terms of Reference (ToR), deliverables and sharing of the credits including intellectual property rights will be laid down with mutual consensus at the beginning of the activities.

4. PERFORMANCE STANDARD

The parties shall perform their respective roles and responsibilities under this MoU with highest standards of professional and ethical competence and integrity. Both Parties shall also respect rules, regulations and policies of both institutions.

5. VALIDITY OF MoU

This MoU shall have provision of periodic review of the activities and progress. This MoU shall be valid initially for a period of five years, which can be extended by mutual agreement. Any cessation of this MoU by either Party shall be notified in writing to the other Party at least 3 (three) months in advance in writing.

Dispute arising out of this MoU, if any, shall be amicably settled by the parties IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Parties hereby execute the MoU in two original copies in English language. The MoU shall be effective on the date it is signed.
